



BENEFITS OF A TEH MEMBERSHIP

TEH NETWORK MEETINGS

- The possibility of hosting a network meeting at your centre where 100–150 cultural staff, researchers, volunteers, students, networks and organisations are represented.
- The right to vote at General Assembly during the network meetings.
- The possibility to receive travel support and/or free accommodation for network meetings (limited availability).

COLLABORATION AND PARTICIPATION

- Active participation in EU-funded projects and staff exchange programmes.
- Active participation in collaborations and projects within TEH: artists' residency network (AIR), Music Freedom Day network, sustainability network, Film & Media network, etc.
- Regular communications from the TEH office; publications, reports, newsletters calls for participation in projects and surveys, etc.

VISIBILITY

- Full circulation of information and media through the TEH website, TEH TV, TEH Flickr account and TEH Facebook account.
- The possibility to promote your centre and activities through the monthly TEH newsletter with around 5,000 international subscribers.
