# **COVID-19 AND TRAVELING TO DENMARK**

This site with <u>FAQ about traveling to Denmark</u> is updated every week and we are following the situation closely.

### **SUMMARY OF THE STATUS IN DENMARK RIGHT NOW:**

#### **Get tested**

Before traveling to Denmark you are required to get tested, as you must provide documentation for a negative test at the border. The test must be made less than 48 hours prior to entering the country. Another test must be made upon arrival.

There are a few exceptions from this rule if you have documentation that you have been fully vaccinated or have already had covid-19. Please read further on the website.

## **Worthy Purpose**

In Denmark, as good as all European countries are considered 'orange' for the time being. All travelers from orange contries are obliged to self-isolate when arriving to their destination, but in certain situations they can break the isolation if they have a worthy purpose. Since 21. April, business meetings have been added to worthy purposes, meaning that you are allowed to break the isolation to participate in business meetings. A conference to which you have been invited in relation to your profession is considered a business meeting.

## Face masks (and weather forecast)

Face masks are mandatory in all public indoor areas including airports, train stations and all kinds of public transportation. Face masks are not required in open air. For that reason – and because it is summer – we are planning to have a lot of the conference workshops and meetings outside. Check the weather forecast before packing your suitcase, make sure to be prepared for some fresh air.
