- 1 Challenges of participative projects (what does not work till now, what drives us crazy, etc);
- 2 Suggested solutions (collective solution finding for the challenges);

- Northern Irish artist and researcher Sheelagh Colclough will talk about some of the methodologies used in her current doctoral research; examining participative art practices in Northern Ireland, with a thematic focus on the areas of value, activism, pedagogy and ethics. Harnessing elements of co-creation, lived experience and allowing space for agonism to develop a process of dialogue based participation and collaboration, Sheelagh will present a brief overview of her approach.
- Zuzana ErnstMoncayo will discuss how some of these kinds of processes feed into the issues and ways of working that Brunnenpassage are interested in and reflect how they might be adapted and developed. You will have a chance to briefly road test the main elements of the methodology through a short group discussion session where you will be responding to ideas and trying out some visual mapping of your conversation.
